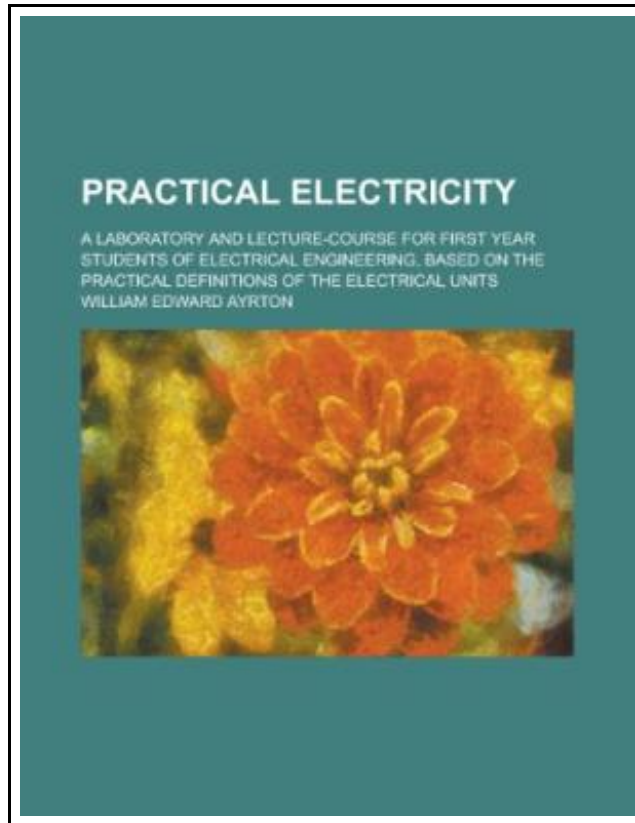

Independence of the Currents in Various Circuits in Parallel. --From what has preceded it follows that if a, c, d, ikc. (Fig. 97) be circuits in parallel with the battery b, the currents A, C, D, and c. , passing through the circuits respectively, will be each independent of the stoppage, or variation, of any, or of all, of the other currents, as long as the combined resistance of the circuits, that is, is large compared with the resistance of the battery, b. Because the current through any one of the circuits simply depends on the potential difference at the terminals of the battery, and on the resistance of the particular circuit. The latter is, of course, not altered by altering the resistance of any or of all the other circuits, and the potential difference at the terminals of the battery remains constant when the above relationship of resistance is fulfilled. Practically, therefore, in all cases where a generator of very small internal resistance is employed, the currents in various parallel circuits fed by it are all independent of one another. And this is one of the great advantages of the very small resistance of accumulators or secondary batteriss, or storage...
