The formula of solidity is given on page 107 of that volume, and need not be repeated. Enter the diagram with the side-height and the width of excavation at the road-bed, for each section; and with the dimensions touched by the diagonal, for each solid. The sum of the three quantities obtained gives the volume of the solid. The dimensions touched by diagonals are the side-height at one end of it and the width of excavation at the road-bed at the other end.
